
URL Disabler v1.2

Users with unrestricted Internet access find themselves constantly battling malware infections and at risk of information leakage. Downloading copyrighted material from the company's network can expose the company to legal action. By blocking some websites greatly reduce this risk and protects accidental browsing of mature, explicit and sensitive sites. It can also help conserve bandwidth for mission critical applications, and keep those charges down.Restricting access to specific URLs may also improve productivity and help staying focused, this point is especially important for children who need to study.



Using software to block websites in order to control Internet access can be beneficial especially to businesses, schools that want to comply with child protection legislation and publicly accessible WiFi services that want to provide a family-friendly browsing environment and Home users.




What is New (Friday, 17 March 2023)

- 1. [FIXED] Application runs very slowly with large entries.

What is URL Disabler and how to use it


URL Disabler is a Portable (it requires no installation) and freeware to simplify the URL blocking process for Google Chrome, Firefox and Chromium EDGE users. The user can freely provide, modify, export and import the list of URLs to be blocked.

1. After download and Unzip it, please run Appropriate exe file (x64 or x86) then Type the URL of the web page you want to block into the URL field (1) and use plus button (Add to list) (2)




2. By default, the setting "Options – Save changes automatically" is checked, which means that when you add an URL to the software you don't need to click the Apply Changes button. If "Automatically save changes" is not selected, use the "Apply changes" button to apply. Easily


block any distracting or harmful website. You can click one of the browser icons at the bottom right to choose which browser to apply or unapply settings to.



Whitelist URLs to set exceptions for websites you would like to allow. You can also choose the browser which the ban will be apply from the menu under options, by default all supported browsers are selected. Under the same menu you can use Password Properties to set the Password for the Application.



Under Examples menu; facebook.com, twitter.com, youtube.com URLs are given as examples. The export and import options are under the file menu, so you can easily reuse the list you created and backed up once.



URL Disabler doesn't use "%SystemRoot%\System32\drivers\etc\hosts" file method therefore resetting the Hosts file does not affect the

URL Disabler does not use the HOSTS file. It blocks URLs typed in the URL bar.

However, you must restart the browser after the blocking process.

If you click the X icon in the lower right corner of the program interface, the selected browsers will be closed. To apply a blanket ban, you can check Enable WhiteList and add URLs that are allowed.

Does this only block URLs as if typing in the URL bar of a browser or does it also work like the HOSTS file, in that it blocks the resolved URL so that if that site is accessed from another site, the service is blocked?

E.g. You can access YouTube by using an app on some websites, e.g. Canva.com, Microsoft Teams, etc. But if you redirect Youtube.com to 127.0.0.1 in Hosts file, YouTube cannot be accessed from anywhere. Does URL Disabler work like this too?

Hi, URL Disabler applies the block to the user session on which it is running.

If you check Options – > Apply to AllUsers, the block will apply to all users.

To set a different block for different users, the "Apply to all users" option should be unchecked. You can open different user sessions and add the block for that user session.


